

# Charlie 119 Restoration Team

A C-119 in Greybull, WY was purchased by the Atterbury-Bakalar Air Museum in May 2019.

Between November 2019 and February 2020 the airplane was disassembled by a contractor in Greybull in preparation for shipment to Columbus by truck.

The airplane components will be shipped to Columbus by truck in March and April 2020.

The local Restoration Team will begin its work once the Charlie 119 components are in Columbus. The components will have to be cleaned and repaired. Missing and damaged parts will have to be replaced. The C-119 aircraft will then be reassembled at its permanent display location in front of the Atterbury-Bakalar Air Museum.
